INFORMATION AVAILABLE FROM MUNICIPAL COURT STAFF

WE CAN

- Explain and answer questions about how the court works.
- Give you general information about court rules, procedures and practices.
- Provide court schedules and how to get a hearing scheduled.
- Provide information from a case file as long as the case is not confidential
- Provide you with court forms and instructions that are available, and check your forms for completeness.
- Give information about court deadlines.

WE CANNOT

- Recommend what actions you could/might take.
- Recommend what words to use in your court papers or what to say in court.
- Research or interpret the law for you.
- Apply the law to the facts of your case.
- Let you talk to the judge outside of court or talk to the judge for you.
- Take sides in a case.
- Change an order signed by the judge.
- Compute deadlines for you.
